

Cookie Policy

Like most websites, this one uses cookies. By accessing the Website, you agree that this Cookie Policy will apply whenever you access the Website on any device.

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer by your browser. You can view full details of the cookies we use and your rights relating to the use of cookies in our <u>Privacy Policy</u>.

Our use of cookies:

We may collect information when you visit the Website, using cookies. The cookies allow us to identify your computer and find out details about your last visit. This enables you to stay logged in (if applicable), and also helps us work out how many new visitors we get each month. They contain information about the use of your computer but they don't store personal information about you (such as your name for example).

We also use Google Analytics cookies. These can tell us a little about the overall demographics of our visitors but do not identify anyone individually, providing only anonymous statistical data. This data helps us to focus on improving your experience of our website.

Turning off cookies:

When you visit our website, you will be asked to accept or decline certain types of cookies. This service is provided by 'CookieBot by Usercentrics'. You can review your consent at any time by clicking the CookieBot icon at the bottom left of any page of our website. Only necessary cookies are placed on your computer until you have explicitly agreed to other cookies.

You can change the settings of your internet browser to erase cookies or block all cookies if you prefer.
